	Regulatory Floodway The Floodway is the channel of a stream plus any adjacent floodplain areas that must be kept free of encroachment so that the 1% annual chance flood can be carried without substantial increases in flood heights (Data from FEMA National Flood Hazard Layer Map)
	Freshwater Emergent Wetland (approximate boundaries) An emergent wetland is the transitional area between permanently wet and dry environments (Data from National Wetland Inventory)
	Freshwater Forested/Shrub Wetland (Approximate boundaries) A wetland dominated by shrubs or trees growing on soils that are inundated or saturated much of the year, but that do not dry out at the surface. (Data from National Wetland Inventory)
