An emergency/special meeting was held on Thursday, August 5, 2021 to discuss and help correct 32 Oakland Ave. also known as The Anchorage and the new paint the applicant was applying without guidance from the Architectural and Historic Review Board. Mr. Peruso, after some personal research decided upon the following colors from Sherwin-Williams Historic samples:

1st floor – SW6433 – Inverness
2nd floor – SW6430 – Great Green
3rd floor – SW6431 – Leap Frog
Top Peaks – SW2839 – Royal Croft Red
Trim – SW6371 – Vanillin
Porch Floor – SW2827 – Colonial Revival Stone or
SW2826 – Colonial Revival Green Stone

The Board determined that this residence was historically important in the Village and that there were too many colors and that although the colors chosen by Mr. Peruso maybe historically accurate they do not work well on The Anchorage. The Board determined that this house was in need of much lighter colors. The Board as well as Mr. Peruso settled on the following colors from Sherwin-Williams:

1st floor – Morris Room Grey
*2nd & 3rd floor – Sandbar
Window w/1864 – Morris Room Grey
Scales - Sandbar
Background of Anchorage – Morris Room Grey
Grid – Vanillin
Window trim – Vanillin
Porch floor – Liberty Pewter
*OPTION for 2nd & 3rd Floor – Natural Tan
