



This purchase is being executed based on the recent NYSDEC inspection in which we were cited for this deficiency under "Part 750.25 of TOGS".

Refrigerated samplers are a niche market and so there are not many manufacturers offering quality units, after exhausting many avenues I was able to procure the following quotes. Of the three quotes, I would only consider 2 of the units to be of usefulness to us and reliable for accurate sampling (they are the HACH and ISCO) the Manning unit quoted below does not even have a heating system to avoid freezing.

As it turns out the inferior Manning unit was also not the lowest price, so I am recommending the lowest cost unit:

Hach model # ASA.CXXX2X21XX with a per unit price of \$4,642.26 with a backup power system.
